Safety Warnings

The installation of the device must comply with the guidelines in IQShare WP40 Quick Guide.

- To prevent injuries and physical damage, always read this manual and all labels on the system before connecting.
- The apparatus must be grounded (earthed) via the supplied power cable. If the supplied power cable is not the correct one, please consult your dealer.
- Only use the power cord supplied with your device. While appearing to be similar, other power cords have not been safety tested at the factory and may not be used to power the device. For a replacement power cord, contact your dealer.
- Do not allow anything to rest on the power cord. Do not locate this product where persons will walk on the cord. To disconnect the cord, pull it out by the plug. Never pull the cord itself.
- Never spill liquid of any kind on the product. Should any liquid or solid object fall into the cabinet, unplug the set and have it checked by qualified service personnel before resuming operations.
- Lightning - For added protection for this product during a lightning storm, or when it is left unattended and unused for long periods of time, unplug it from the wall outlet. This will prevent damage to the device due to lightning and AC power-line surges.
- Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.

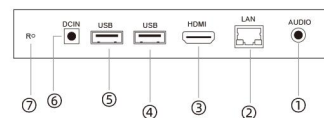

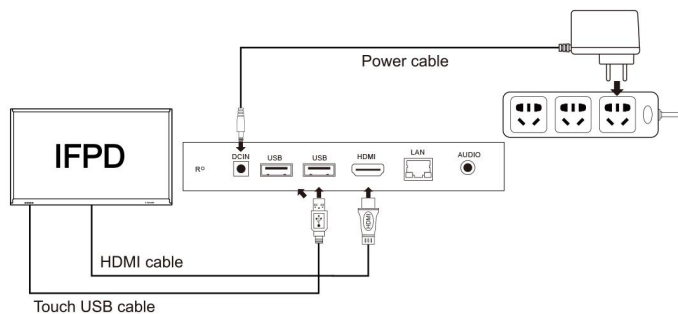
Ports Illustration

- ⑦ Reset

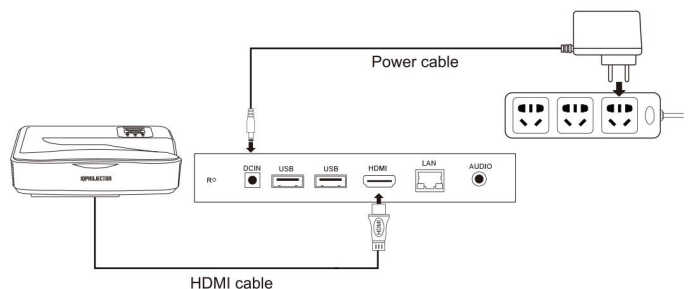
Connection

Connect with touch screen



1. Power on IQShare Box.
2. Connect IQShare Box and display screen with HDMI cable and touch USB cable.

Connect with projector



1. Power on IQShare Box.
2. Connect IQShare Box and projector with HDMI cable.

Note:
Connect IQShare Box with external device through HDMI cable.

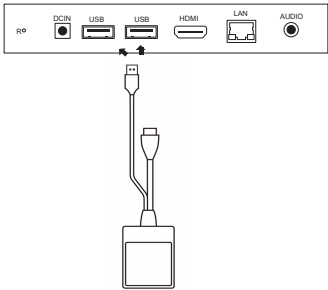
Enable the device

HDMI Button (Optional)

1.The indicator light will turn blue when power on. The main interface of IQShare Box will show on the display screen.



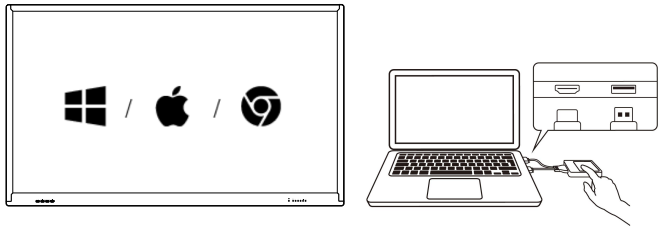
2. Plug USB cable of IQShare Button to USB port of IQShare Box. Pull out after pairing successfully.



3.Plug IQShare Button to laptop HDMI and USB port.

4.Press the button to share screen.

(The IQShare Button should be paired with the IQShare Box for the first time connection.)



USB Button (Optional)

- 1.Plug IQShare Button to USB port of IQShare Box. Pull out after pairing successfully.
- 2.Plug IQShare Button to laptop USB port.
- 3.Press the button to share screen.



Note:
If it is the first time to use the IQShare Button (USB) with your Windows PC, please double click "ShareMax.exe" in: PC > CD Drive.

For PC, with the application installed, IQShare Button (USB) will launch automatically after the button is plugged into the PC.

USB-C Button (Optional)

- 1.Plug IQShare Button attached USB-C converter to USB port of IQShare Box. Pull out after pairing successfully and unplug the USB-C converter.
- 2.Plug IQShare Button to laptop USB-C port.
- 3.Press the button to share screen.

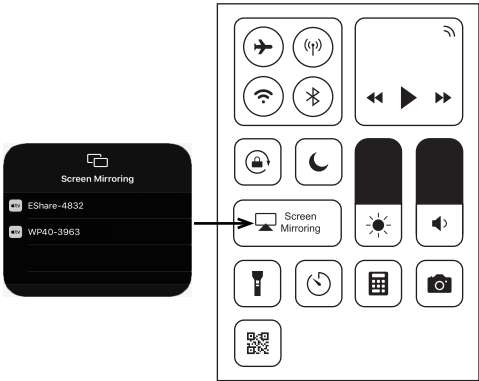


Note:
Device supports fully featured USB Type-C function that covers USB & DP.

Mobile Casting

iOS Casting

Make sure the iPhone and display device are connected to the same network, or use the hotspot of the IQShare Box. Select screen mirroring (Airplay protocol), select the target device and open mirror, share the mobile screen to the display device.



Android Casting

Make sure your phone is under the same network with IQShare WP40 or use the hotspot of IQShare WP40. Scan the QR code to download the app, after installing, open the app, it will search the display device under the same network automatically, select the target device to share the mobile screen.
